#### WHAT IS MAP GROWTH TESTING?

MAP Growth Testing is an adaptive assessment tool developed by the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) in the USA. It measures students' academic progress in key areas such as reading and mathematics for Grades 1 and 2, and includes language usage for Grades 3 to 6. The test adjusts its difficulty based on each student's responses, providing a personalized assessment experience.


