## G5 SIAMAYA CHOCOLATE FACTORY

On Thursday, April 24, 2026, the Grade 5 students enjoyed an exciting and educational visit to the Siamaya Chocolate Factory, where they learned how cacao beans are grown by local Thai farmers using natural and sustainable methods. The students explored the chocolate-making process, from roasting and grinding the beans to mixing ingredients to create the final product. They were fascinated to see how materials change state, which connected to their classroom learning about chemical reactions and the history of cocoa. The students had the opportunity to make their own chocolate and take part in a taste-testing session. The visit encouraged them to think about the importance of supporting local businesses and making environmentally friendly choices.



## SCRAPS TO SOIL PROJECT

As a part of their CAS project (Creativity, Activity, Service), the Grade 11 students have started a food waste composting project to reduce the waste that ends up in landfills, which becomes a source of methane, a potent Greenhouse Gas. The students have created a new food waste sorting system in the cafeteria, helping the community separate leftovers, recyclables, and general waste more effectively. Clear labels and designated bins make it easier for everyone to follow the process. Also, they have spent time educating the entire school on how the new waste segregation system works. This week, they produced their first batch of compost!

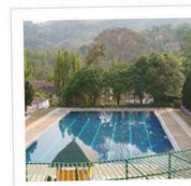
